

**Recommendations for the best method
of labeling our plant markers**

We have 3 recommendations for labeling your plant markers



In our personal gardens we have used a Brother P-Touch printer and Brother's TZ Style laminated weatherproof label material since 1999. To date, we have never had a label fade or peel off the markers.

Option #1 Brother P-Touch / TZe Labels



We prefer using TZ Style label material with black letters on white background. Many of these original labels are still in our garden and are just as legible as when we first put them there.

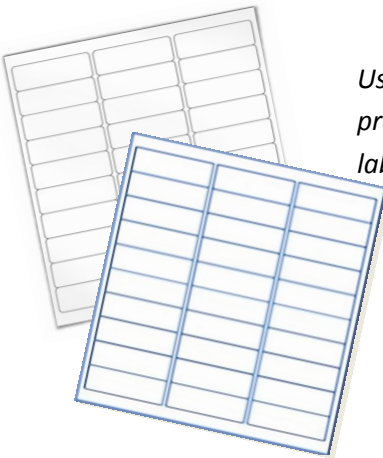
Brother P-Touch printers and TZ Style laminated weatherproof label material are typically available at office supply stores such as Office Depot, Office Max, Staples, etc. Check out our website for current Brother printers available for purchase in our online store at www.kincaidplantmarkers.com.

Brother makes several different models of label printers with a host of different features : label widths, battery and/or A/C adapter power, personal computer connectivity, handheld or desktop models and more.

One important option to be sure of is whether the printer will print the TZ Style laminated weatherproof label material. A couple of models will not, as they are for indoor printing applications only. We have available on our website several of the most popular TZ Style label materials, suitable for long-term outdoor labeling.

Option #2 Label with UV Cover



Using a white weatherproof address style label and adding a clear protective label to help block the sun's ultraviolet rays and keep the label from fading.

White address style labels can be written on, if you have good penmanship, or they can also be printed on using a laser style printer. Labels are 1" x 2 - 5/8" and come packaged 30 to a sheet. We bundle 1 sheet of both the white and clear labels together and offer them for one low price for your convenience.



Option #3 Paint Pen



Paint pens also work well with our plant markers and come in many colors, but are very permanent. You can use mineral spirits and a rag to remove the paint if necessary. We currently offer the Markal HP in black. Markal item # 96963

Methods that do not work well are marking pens, china marking pencils, grease pencils, etc. The stainless steel surface of our plate is too smooth to pick up the marking using these methods.
